Incredible Years Autism - Teacher (IYA-T)

Junior school teachers are invited to register for IYA-T courses in Hamilton for 2026. Registration criteria: The teacher needs to have a child in their class aged 5 or 6 who has been diagnosed with autism or displays characteristics consistent with autism. This programme is run over 6 sessions (9am-12.30pm) with visits after session 2 and 4. The teacher release payment from MOE is \$900.00 per teacher.
